Fundación CreSeremos was born from a spirit of solidarity built over the years, driven by families, friends, and individuals sensitive to the realities of poverty and inequality faced by many communities in Colombia.



Before becoming a foundation, we were action: improving housing, delivering school supplies and clothing, and supporting children in accessing sports, artistic, recreational, and educational spaces that would otherwise be out of their reach.

Over time, we witnessed a recurring reality in rural areas: forgotten communities, urgent unmet needs, and resources that do not always reach those who need them most. Education, human development, and overall well-being are often left behind.

Tired of only observing and acting in isolation, we decided to organize ourselves, formalize our commitment, and expand our impact.

This is how **Fundación CreSeremos was born**: as a group of people with a deep social vocation who chose to structure their efforts in order to expand their impact, sustain it over time, and build alliances with organizations that believe in conscious and transformative social responsibility.

Our name reflects our essence. **CreSeremos** combines “to grow” and “to be”: a deep conviction that true development begins by strengthening the human being in all dimensions. It is an invitation to **grow with purpose, dignity, and in community.**

We work in rural areas such as **Fúquene**, where we have supported six schools through educational, recreational, and capacity-building activities. We have provided learning games, school supplies, clothing and backpack donations. We have also developed workshops in robotics and aerodynamics that broaden learning opportunities for children.

Building on this experience, we aim to develop more comprehensive initiatives that strengthen the role of schools as spaces for community connection and educational, cultural, and social growth.

In addition, we promote initiatives such as “**Hands that Learn**,” through which we support income-generating training processes for rural women.

In La Guajira, within **the Wayuu community of Capuchirramana**, we have begun by supporting artisan families and are developing initiatives focused on water access and educational strengthening.

Our approach is built on two fundamental pillars:

- Education as a driver of social transformation
- Strengthening income-generating initiatives that promote economic autonomy, community sustainability, and the well-being of future generations



We firmly believe that when individuals grow, communities flourish. And together, we will grow and become.

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
